

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT Adjunct Instructor - Statistics

The University seeks a part-time *Adjunct Instructor* to teach Introductory Statistics classes for its Mathematics Department on the Mount Vernon main campus.

Responsibilities for this position include:

- Adequately prepare all course materials and lessons (note that preparation time will vary based on instructor experience in teaching that course)
- Provide each student with clear course expectations, evaluations and timelines through carefully written topical outlines and approved, standardized syllabus
- Provide interesting and relevant assignments for students that demonstrate learning outcomes in a real-life setting
- Suitably challenge, engage, serve and communicate with students to encourage their participation and learning while maintaining mutual value and respect
- Complete grade books, final grade sheets, learning assessments and final exam assessments in a timely manner
- Respond to student questions in a timely manner
- Identify and refer at-risk students to specific academic support services
- Ensure course and program learning outcomes are delivered as defined by the syllabus

Expectations for the successful candidate:

- Evangelical Christian confession of faith and experience (Statement of Faith required at application)
- Candidate must have obtained at least a conferred Master's Degree from an accredited U.S. college/university or international equivalent, additional requirements driven by state licensing or accreditation considerations may apply
- Expertise in interpersonal and oral presentation/written communication skills
- Engaging classroom style and appreciation of successful instructional approaches for a range of academic abilities
