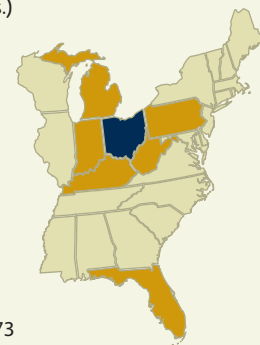

### CoSMO

### Mandate
