Student Assessment and Learning Committee (description reproduced from Faculty Handbook, summer 2014)

The Student Assessment and Learning Committee provides direction regarding assessment plans, tools, and/or experiences related to student curricular and cocurricular learning. The committee reviews assessment results annually and reports to the faculty and administration concerning these results.

The Student Assessment Committee is composed of the Director of Assessment and Reporting (chair), the Director of Graduate and Professional Studies and Enrollment, one Campus Ministries representative, one Student Life representative, two members of Student Government Association, and one faculty member from each academic school.

Parameters of Responsibility:

- 1. Link student learning outcomes to the University's mission, goals and objectives.
- 2. Establish a timetable for administering the assessment instruments selected by the committee, and work to publicize these dates.
- 3. Approve methods of assessing student learning outcomes as proposed by units (departments and divisions).
- 4. Review the results of institutional learning assessment instruments administered to students, and provide an analysis of the findings with appropriate recommendations to departments and the General Education Committee, and divisions responsible for co-curricular learning.
- 5. Develop a plan for educating and informing faculty, administration, and students of the purposes and outcomes of student learning assessment.
- 6. Recommend strategies for improving student learning.
- 7. Periodically evaluate the effectiveness of the student learning outcomes assessment program.

The Student Assessment and Learning Committee reports its work to the CAO and the Academic Leadership Team.
