Residence Hall or Apartment Notes:

Some beds on campus use regular twin size sheets and some use long twin sized sheets. We recommend buying sheets that are longer so that they will fit both types of mattresses. If you need an extra-long mattress, please put in a facilities ticket through your portal.

Carpets may not be taped, glued, nailed, or affixed to the floor in any way.

Residence Hall windows have mini blinds. There are no curtain rods. Please bring spring tension rods for hanging curtains.

All Living spaces have provided air conditioners that are installed. Please do not bring your own.

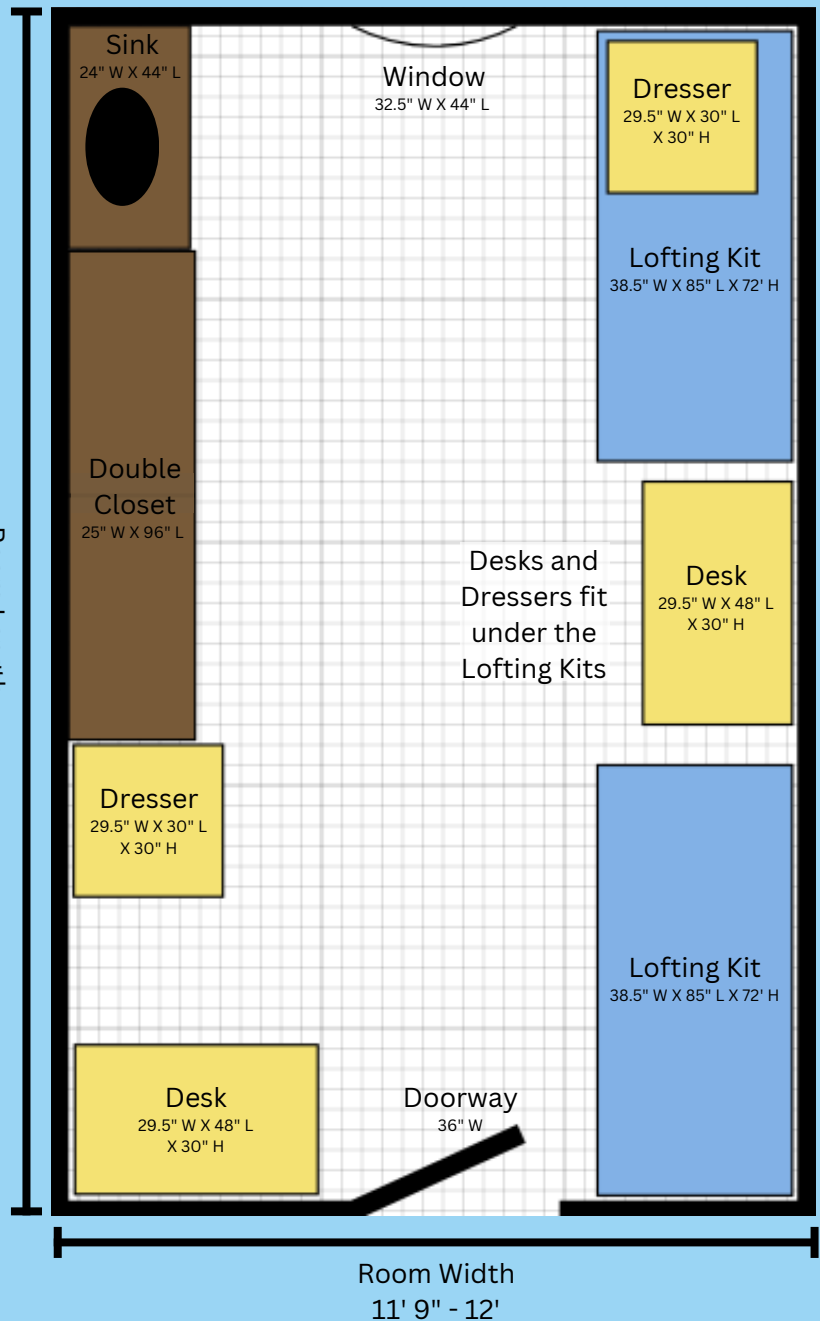
- Fans are permitted.
- Space heaters are not permitted.

If you are a transfer student, you may be placed in a Residence Hall or possibly one of our townhouse style apartments. Each apartment houses six students and has three bedrooms, two bathrooms, a small kitchenette, and a living room. Furniture is provided for apartments (beds, desk chairs, living room furniture, and one under-the-counter refrigerator).

- Students in the apartments are permitted to have their own personal refrigerator in the room.
- Apartment window = 37.25" wide X 46" high

All University furniture must remain in the designated hall rooms or apartments. Please refrain from submitting tickets for furniture removal.
