Adjunct Instructor – Web Design

- Adequately prepare all course materials and lessons
- Provide each student with clear course expectations, evaluations and timelines through carefully written topical outlines and approved, standardized syllabus
- Provide interesting and relevant assignments for students that demonstrate learning outcomes in a real-life setting
- Suitably challenge, engage, serve and communicate with students to encourage their participation and learning while maintaining mutual value and respect
- Complete grading, and final exam assessments in a timely manner
- Respond to student questions in a timely manner
- Identify and refer at-risk students to specific academic support services
- Ensure course and program learning outcomes are delivered as defined by the syllabus

Minimum Qualifications:

- Master's degree in web design, graphic design or a related field preferred and/or
- Five years professional experience and expertise in the field of web design or graphic design
- Have knowledge in HTML/CSS
- SEO Strategies
- Content Management Systems
- Knowledge in responsive web design, some content writing, branding, and color theory

Expectations for the successful candidate:

- Evangelical Christian confession of faith and experience (Statement of Faith required at application)
- Expertise in interpersonal and oral presentation/written communication skills
- Engaging classroom style and appreciation of successful instructional approaches for a range of academic abilities
