The Music Department offers a variety of avenues to pursue a quality music education. The baccalaureate program allows students to choose from a B.A. in Music Education or a B.A. in Music with a choice of two tracks: Music Performance or General Music. Another option, in collaboration with the School of Christian Ministry, is a Worship Arts program that focuses on four core areas: Music, Christian Ministry, Graphic Design, and Media/Communication. Also offered are two music minors and a two-year associate degree.

Participation in various ensembles is encouraged and open to the entire student body. Choral groups include Collegians Chorale, Una Voce Chamber Choir, Treble Singers Women's Choir, Choral Union, and Music Stage Production. Instrumental groups include Symphonic Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, Flute Choir, Pep Band and String Ensemble. Private lessons are also offered in most band and orchestral instruments, guitar, piano, organ, voice, and composition.
